Richmond Road School is an Auckland primary school comprised of four Rōpū or language units of Te Reo, French, Samoan and English. Founded in 1884, Richmond Road is now well established in the Grey Lynn/Ponsonby community, and enjoys a long history of progressive and bilingual primary education. Richmond Road students experience our unique and rich tradition of a multi-cultural educational environment. Concepts such as tuakana-teina and fa'aloalo feature strongly across all Rōpū of the school.

Richmond Road is committed to providing bilingual education for its students as part of a comprehensive strategy for long term academic achievement in the context of a multi-cultural, urban setting. This is grounded in research that demonstrates higher achievement through bilingual opportunities.

Beyond our focus on academic excellence for all students, Richmond Road School holds the values of cultural respect, tolerance and celebrating difference, creativity and kotahitanga which are all core to the Richmond Road experience on and off our school grounds. Our motto of "Aim High – Whaia Te Iti Kahurangi – Tauivi Malosi – Visez Haut" is the overriding goal for our students, as we have a strong desire for them to be future leaders. We want to prepare our tamariki with a solid academic base and confidence in their own identity while fostering a love for learning.

Richmond Road staff are currently involved in developing their Teacher as Inquiry Model; Leadership and Assessment across the core curriculum areas; and Positive Behaviour for Learning (PB4L) which is currently focused on training the leaders and then the staff in the Incredible Years Programme in 2014. Both Te Whānau Whāriki and Mua i Malae have engaged in whole school professional development as well as engaged with specific development to meet their needs.

The Richmond Road School community is committed to the arts and performance. Many of the parents of the students work in the media and the arts. This translates into a real appreciation for storytelling, performance, music, song and dance - all of which is reflected in the students' activities and focus. A wealth of creative talent and the encouragement to explore the arts give Richmond Road students a sense of confidence in communication and presentation.

Students have a wide range of opportunities to engage in Sport. Richmond Road competes well in inter-city competitions and often distinguishes itself with a win but always in sportsmanship and school spirit. Our close proximity to Grey Lynn Park means plenty of opportunity for outdoor events. Our brand new hall has recently allowed for many assemblies and performances that bring the four rōpū together under one roof.
