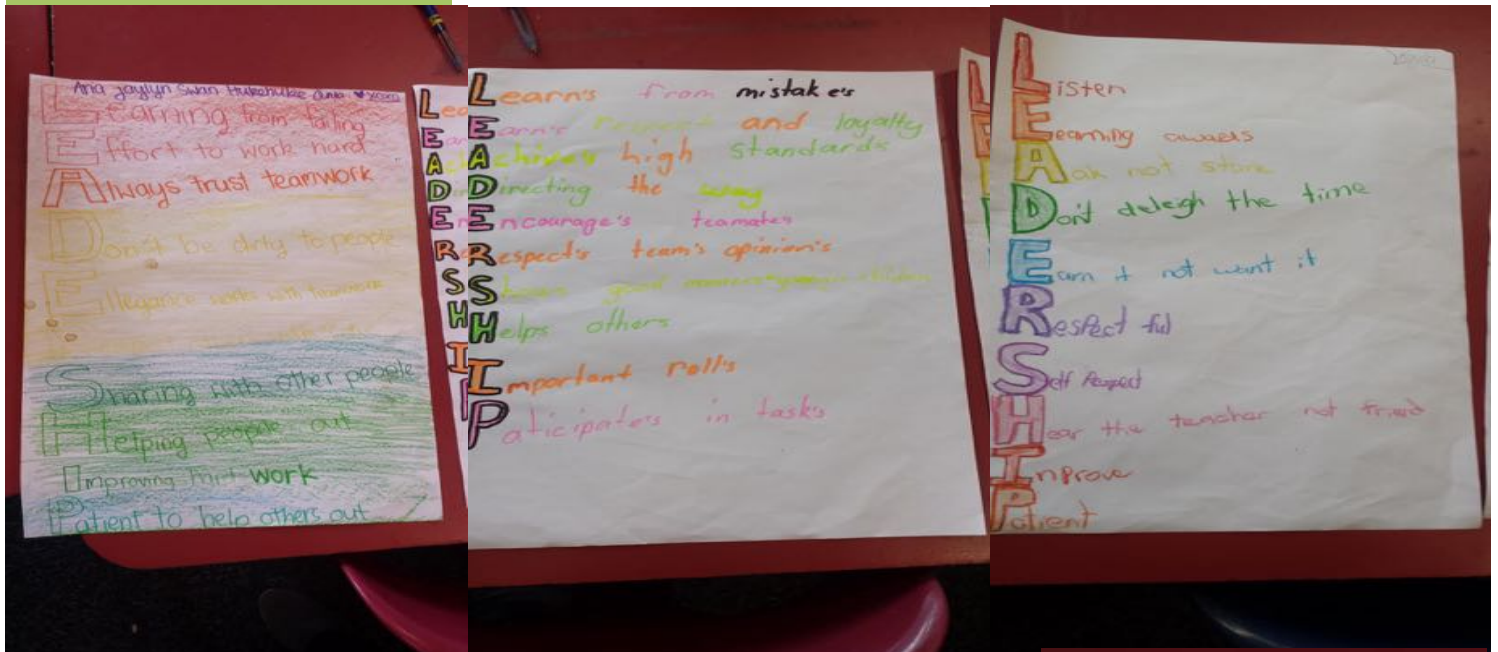
Village Awards- Last week these students received special mention and an award. Well done Villagers!

Blogs are back for 2016! Our blogs have a slightly new look to accommodate our new Innovative Learning Environments. Look at the labels to find your child's home and learning groups.

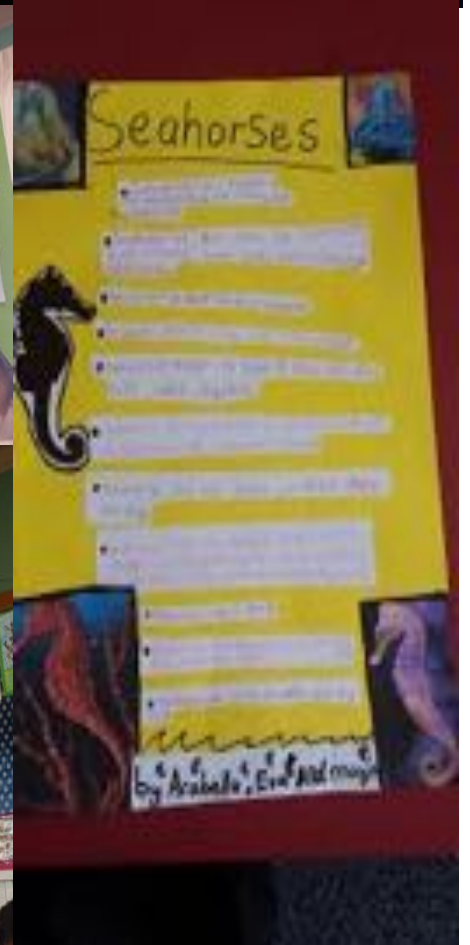
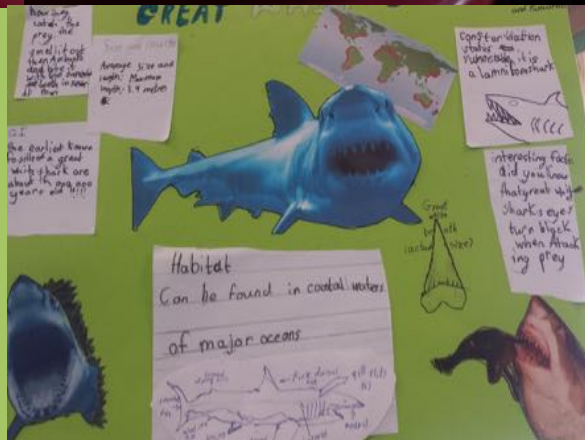
