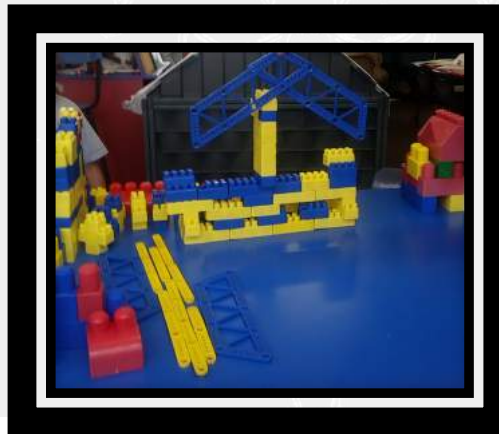


Te Whānau Whaariki
