

Richmond Road School Enrolments for 2025

The Richmond Road School Board invites applications for enrolment for all students wishing to attend Richmond Road School in 2025.

Parents of students who live in the school zone should apply to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year. Students who live in the school zone are entitled to enrol in the school.

Students who apply for our special programmes (Māori immersion unit, Samoan bilingual unit or French bilingual unit) are selected based on criteria set out in the enrolment scheme (see our website https://www.richmondroad.school.nz/enrolment.html). Applications can be dropped off at the School Office or sent electronically to office@richmondroad.school.nz.

If the number of applicants who meet the criteria exceed the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot or points system (dependent on the criteria of the special programme). If a ballot is required, it will be held on Friday 18th October.

The approximate number of spaces for 2025 are:

Te Whānau Whāriki (Māori)

12 spaces

Mua I Malae (Samoan)

14 spaces

L'Archipel (French)

15 spaces

Kiwi Connection (English)

15 spaces for out of zone students
