

**RRS Level 3 Specific Guidelines for whānau and students**

School is open for level 3 students with very clear guidelines around restricting contact and limiting the amount of people that are on school site. We are ONLY open at level 3 for students who have no one at home and need to be supervised. These are the guidelines that whānau and students must follow if they are on the level 3 roll. There is medium risk of community transmission in active but managed clusters. School hours 8.40-3.00pm

<p>Note: These are strict drop off times. We will not be admitting any parents on site and we will have staff doing the roll and escorting from the gates at ONLY these times.</p>

<u>Device</u> <u>Headphones</u>	<p>Your child should bring a device and headphones to school to undertake any distance learning by their 'regular' teacher.. Please ensure it is fully charged before they arrive at school. There may be some available at school if children do not have one. Please let us know if your child needs one to use.</p>	Parents
<u>Behaviour</u>	<p>It is a Health and Safety issue and a mandated Public Health requirement for children to follow the instructions of staff at all times. Children must listen to all staff and follow physical distancing rules. If there are any instances of Health and Safety breaches, parents will be rung immediately to pick up their child/children.</p>	Parents  Staff
<u>Exiting School</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>School bubble Tahi exit strictly between 2.40-3.00 Gate 1</li> <li>School bubble Rua exit strictly between 2.40-3.00 Gate 2</li> <li>School bubble Tour exit strictly between 2.40-3.00 Gate 2</li> </ul> <p>Gate 1 - Douglas Street    Gate 2 - Brown Street</p>	JED Staff

Note: You must pick your child up between these times at the right gate. We will not be admitting any parents on site and we will have staff doing the roll and waiting at the gate at ONLY these times.

**Note:** School bubbles will be made up of two or three adults (in rotation) and up to 10 students. Extended bubbles are limited in level 3. This IS your child's/family's extended bubble and also our staff's extended bubble. Please ensure you are adhering to this during this time when we want to ensure the health of ALL our school community. As we have limited staff on site and we are in a pandemic it is important that

all students and staff are as safe as possible. If you bring your child to school as part of the level 3 roll you are agreeing to abide by these terms. Masks are voluntary for children under 12. We respect the right for whānau to make decisions on this aspect. Please ensure your child is able to place and displace their mask correctly if they are using one as we will not be able to assist them.
